FINANCIAL POLICIES

Registration Process – Registration is not complete until the first month’s tuition and the entrance fee have been paid.

Billing Procedures – For your convenience, the annual tuition charge is divided into ten installments and billed August through May. The monthly installment plan is designed to help parents spread the cost of tuition over ten months and does not signify the cost of education per month. No refunds will be made for a partial month upon a student’s withdrawal. A monthly statement will be mailed or emailed to the responsible party on the 5th day of the month.

Tuition and any applied fees are due on the 15th of each month. A late fee of \$25 per student may be charged and any discounts and/or tuition assistance matching funds will be forfeited if payment is not made by the end of each month. A history of checks returned for insufficient funds may result in a request that payments be made in cash or money order. Families with a Work Match Scholarship and/or a history of past due payments may be required to enroll in an automatic payment plan.

Delinquent Accounts – Students with past due accounts may not be allowed to take exams and will not receive transcripts. Participation in extracurricular activities involving additional costs may be forfeited until the account is paid in full or satisfactory arrangements have
