This program was founded in 2006, inspired by a child who connected with an older adult, creating a lifelong friendship. We are currently partnered with 150+

PFE Statistics

2,000+ students participate each year 727,757 hours of isolation eased since 2006 \$10.5 million in tuition assistance since 2006 25% of K-12 NAD schools are participating Grades K-8 Earning Potential: \$1,000 per year Grades 9-12 Earning Potential: \$1,600 per year

Grades K-8 Programming


- Participant spots are based on enrollment
 - \circ Enrollment > 30 = 20% participation
 - \circ Enrollment < 30 = 50% participation
- Participants are paired with a senior in the community (no relatives)
- Student visits mentor for one hour, once per week
- Students and mentors form a friendship through shared activities
- Students submit a reflection following each visit
- Local coordinator reviews reflections weekly for approval
- Scholarship: \$25 per visit
 - $\circ~70\%$ funded by SFFC Foundation
 - o 30% fundraised by your school community
 - Paid monthly

Grades 9-12 Programming

- Participant spots are based on enrollment
 - \circ Enrollment > 30 = 20% participation
 - \circ Enrollment < 30 = 50% participation
- Participants are paired with a senior in the community (no relatives)
- Student completes 1 Qualifying Unit per week
- Qualifying Unit = 2 visit hours and a reflection
- Must complete a specific amount of Qualifying Units per semester to be eligible the following semester
- Local coordinator reviews reflections weekly for approval
- Scholarship: \$800 per semester
 - 70% funded by SFFC Foundation
 - 30% fundraised by your school community
 - Paid in November and April
