I understand and agree to follow the PFE guidelines presented in the student and parent/guardian orientation and listed on sffcoundation.org/pfe website. Below is an outline of some of the guidelines.

- ☐ Support your local PFE team in selecting a great mentor match for your child
 - The mentor cannot be a relative
 - Two students cannot share a mentor
- ☐ Attend student/parent orientation each year.
- ☐ Help your child set up an account on the reporting website/ highschoolers can set up their own accounts
- ☐ Schedule visits and transportation for your child to and from their weekly visit
- ☐ K-8 Parents are required to attend and supervise the child's weekly visits
- ☐ Make sure your child submits a reflection after each visit (within 24 hours), 9-12 grade submit **during** the visit.
- ☐ Communicate with your local PFE coordinator about any concerns or challenges
- ☐ Scholarships will be awarded when the student/family fulfills the participation and time requirements as outlined in the orientation packet.
- ☐ If you are unable to commit, your child may need to be removed from the program so a spot can be given to another family.

Making these commitments is crucial to your child's success in PFE.
